

The Boy Scouts of America created this recognition to raise awareness of the need for organ donors in our communities, and to help Scouts realize their ability to impact a person's choice to be a donor.

Requirements

There are NO formal requirements for this patch. Each unit establishes the procedure for awarding the patch, No. 5152. Usually, a Donor Awareness patch is presented to a Scout the first time he succeeds in recruiting an adult family member, friend, relative, or other acquaintance as an organ donor, and to fill out and carry an organ donor card.

Obtaining the Patch

Once it is determined that the patch is available, submit an advancement report to the council and purchase the patch from the council service center. Typically, a boy will only be eligible to earn one patch.
